



Request for Expressions of Interest Short-Term Individual Consultant

The Nordic Development Fund (NDF) is seeking an individual consultant for a potential assignment in West Africa (Senegal and Benin). The scope of works and relevant details are presented in the Terms of Reference (TOR) for the assignment.

Interested consultants are kindly required to submit CVs outlining relevant experience for the assignment as outlined in the TOR in the last five (5) years, as well as education and language skills. Please note that the assignment requires professional adequacy in written French as the scope of works include drafting TOR in the French language.

Duration of the assignment:

The assignment is expected to require no more than 25 working days, including two weeks in the field (one in Senegal, tentatively in the last week of November, and one in Benin, tentatively mid-December).

Requirements:

- at least a Master's degree in relevant field of engineering;
- at least 15 years of relevant work experience;
- experience from working in Francophone West Africa;
- fluent written and spoken English and French.

Submission requirements:

In the email the interested consultants are required to indicate their availability to carry out the assignment, including travelling to Senegal and Benin, and proposed timeline for the assignment and dates for travel, in the last week of November and the first three weeks of December. The interested consultants are further required to assure, in writing in the submission email, that they have sufficient skills to prepare TOR in the French language. The interested consultants are also required to submit their daily fees (not including travel costs such as tickets and accommodation).

The selection method is Individual Selection, and NDF will make a qualitative appraisal of the submissions. Non-selected consultants will not receive any feedback on their submissions.

The successful candidate will be invited to negotiate the TOR, timeline for implementation of the assignment as well as the contract. Target date for such negotiation is in the first week of November.
